

Delta Family Clinic Psychological Testing Information

The information below is intended to provide a better understanding of what to expect on the day of the patient's evaluation. Items pertaining to children (i.e. individuals under the age of 18) are noted in italics.

Psychological Evaluation (Parents/Guardians are not to sit in during the testing process.)

- These evaluations typically take anywhere between 3-5 hours. ***(A parent/guardian must remain in the clinic for the duration of the appointment.)***
 - Breaks are offered in approximately 30 minute intervals.
 - ***The examinee is allowed to bring any special 'toys' (i.e. stuffed animals, etc.) into the evaluation if you believe it will improve the likelihood of participation.***
 - The examinee should **not** arrive to the appointment on an empty stomach. All examinees are welcome to bring snacks to their appointments and eat during break times.
 - We are able to provide water for the examinee at any point during the evaluation.
 - ***If the examinee is being seen for a possible Asperger's/Autism diagnosis, the parent/guardian should be prepared to fill out some extra paperwork before the examinee leaves.***
 - Examinees should **not** make any changes to routine medications on the day of the evaluation.

Neuropsychological Evaluation (Parents/Guardians are not to sit in during the testing process.)

- These evaluations typically take anywhere between 7-10 hours. ***(A parent/guardian must remain in the clinic for the duration of the appointment.)***
 - Breaks are offered in approximately 30 minute intervals with a mandatory 1-hour break halfway through the evaluation. Patients are welcome to leave the clinic during this time.
 - ***The examinee is allowed to bring any special 'toys' (i.e. stuffed animals, etc.) into the evaluation if you believe it will improve the likelihood of participation.***
 - The examinee should **not** arrive to the appointment on an empty stomach. All examinees are welcome to bring snacks to their appointments and eat during break times.
 - We are able to provide water for the examinee at any point during the evaluation.
 - ***If the examinee is being seen for a possible Asperger's/Autism diagnosis, the parent/guardian should be prepared to fill out some extra paperwork before the examinee leaves.***
 - Examinees should **not** make any changes to routine medications on the day of the evaluation.

ALL TESTING PATIENTS PLEASE NOTE: Any vision or hearing aids should be worn to the testing appointment. Issues regarding transportation should be handled/addressed prior to scheduling testing appointments. As stated in the clinic's financial agreement, if any scheduling conflict should arise, patients are required to notify Delta Family Clinic 24+ hours in advance, or a \$35 no-show fee will be assessed.
